1. Book of James

2. Westminster Confession of Faith Study

Join us for a study of the Westminster Confession of Faith, the stellar achievement of the English Reformation which concisely distills biblical truth in succinct, theologically rich statements touching on major areas of faith and practice. Using Williamson’s classic study guide as our road map through the Confession, our doctrinal study will explore timeless, life-changing biblical truths that are both profoundly beautiful and intensely practical.

3. A Praying Church
