

2023–2024 Christian School Scholarship Application

A deceased couple, members of Westminster Presbyterian church, had a love for children and a deep concern for their spiritual growth. Although they had no children of their own, they wished to help influence the lives of young people in their spiritual development through Christian education. As part of their estate planning they gifted a portion of their estate to be used to provide scholarships for students enrolled at primary or secondary level (K–12) Christian schools.

These funds are only intended to provide assistance in tuition support, and the dollar amount available is variable depending upon the number of applicants and the amount of interest accrued each year.

FINANCIAL GUIDELINE: FAMILY ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME (AGI)

- Family income up to \$87,935 with one child
- Family income up to \$101,463 with two children
- Family income up to \$114,992 with three children
- Family income up to \$128,520 with four children

Families with income over these thresholds should not apply for scholarship funds.

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Christian School Scholarship Application Terms and Guidelines

Terms of Assistance. Tuition assistance will be granted one year at a time. There will be no automatic renewal. Each potential recipient will need to reapply for consideration annually. **Recipients are expected to submit an annual written report on their educational experience using a provided form. This form will be sent out at the beginning of February and due back by the end of February.** Parents, their covenant children and students who are communicant members will need to demonstrate and maintain regular church attendance in order to be eligible. Failure of the student and parents to report will result in a disqualification for the following year. Distribution checks will only be issued to the educational institution.

Application Deadline. Applications for scholarship will be made available at the beginning of April and due by the beginning of May. Each year's deadline date will be specified on the current year's application.

Unexpected Need. Special tuition needs, such as for assisted learning programs recommended by the school, can be awarded upon request by the parent, subject to availability, with the equivalent of up to half the amount of the previously determined distribution gift.
