- Return your application and deposit to Jen Barrall.
   Deposit amounts: \$50 by the early bird deadline; \$75
   by the final deadline. Teams may reach capacity prior
   to deadlines. Priority is given to applications in the

#### **COMMIT TO:**

- Rest in Jesus, knowing He is the One who equips you, sustains you, and provides for your every need.
- Have a servant's heart and flexible spirit.
- Attend at least 75% of team meetings and events. On average, teams meet 4–6 times.
- Submit to the team leadership.
- Enlist a minimum of ten prayer partners.
- Colombia, LEAP, Easton, & Yakama Trips: Participate in raising financial support with your team. Team members are asked to personally contribute or raise as much of the trip cost as possible. Up to 30% of the trip cost for WPC members may be subsidized from the missions budget. All Trips: Non-members must raise the entire trip cost. Listed trip costs are estimates and may change.
- Complete a background check, as required by Pennsylvania State law.
- Be up to date on required immunizations (routine childhood and Tetanus for <u>all trips</u>; additional immunizations or antimalaria medication may be recommended or required for different trips).

#### OTHER WAYS TO BE INVOLVED:

- Pray for the team, those they will meet, and their ministry.
- Support the teams financially or donate supplies.
- Consider involvement in a short-term missions internship.
