MEN'S BREAKFAST



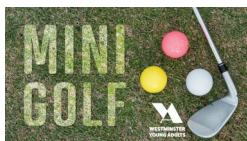

YOUNG ADULTS MINI GOLF

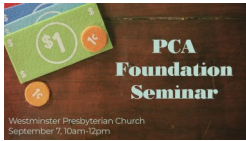
